Goal: Follow a Step-by-Step Plan

ingredients











250 g flower

1 packet of vanilla sugar

100 g sugar

1 egg

125 g butter

recipe

- Mix the flour, sugar, vanilla sugar, egg and butter in a bowl
- Knead into a firm dough
- Roll into a ball and leave in the fridge for 30 minutes .
- Shake some flour on the worktop and roll out the dough to a thickness of 1 cm.
- And then comes the best part (apart from eating): cut out the dough in nice shapes.

bake

- Preheat the oven to 175°C degrees
- Grease a baking tray or put a sheet of baking paper on it and put the cookies on it
- Bake the cookies in the oven for 15 to 20 minutes
