plant eater.

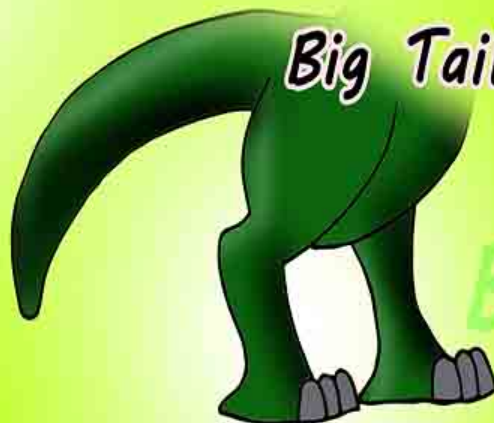


Big Teeth

go out for dinner, OK Jeremy?"*

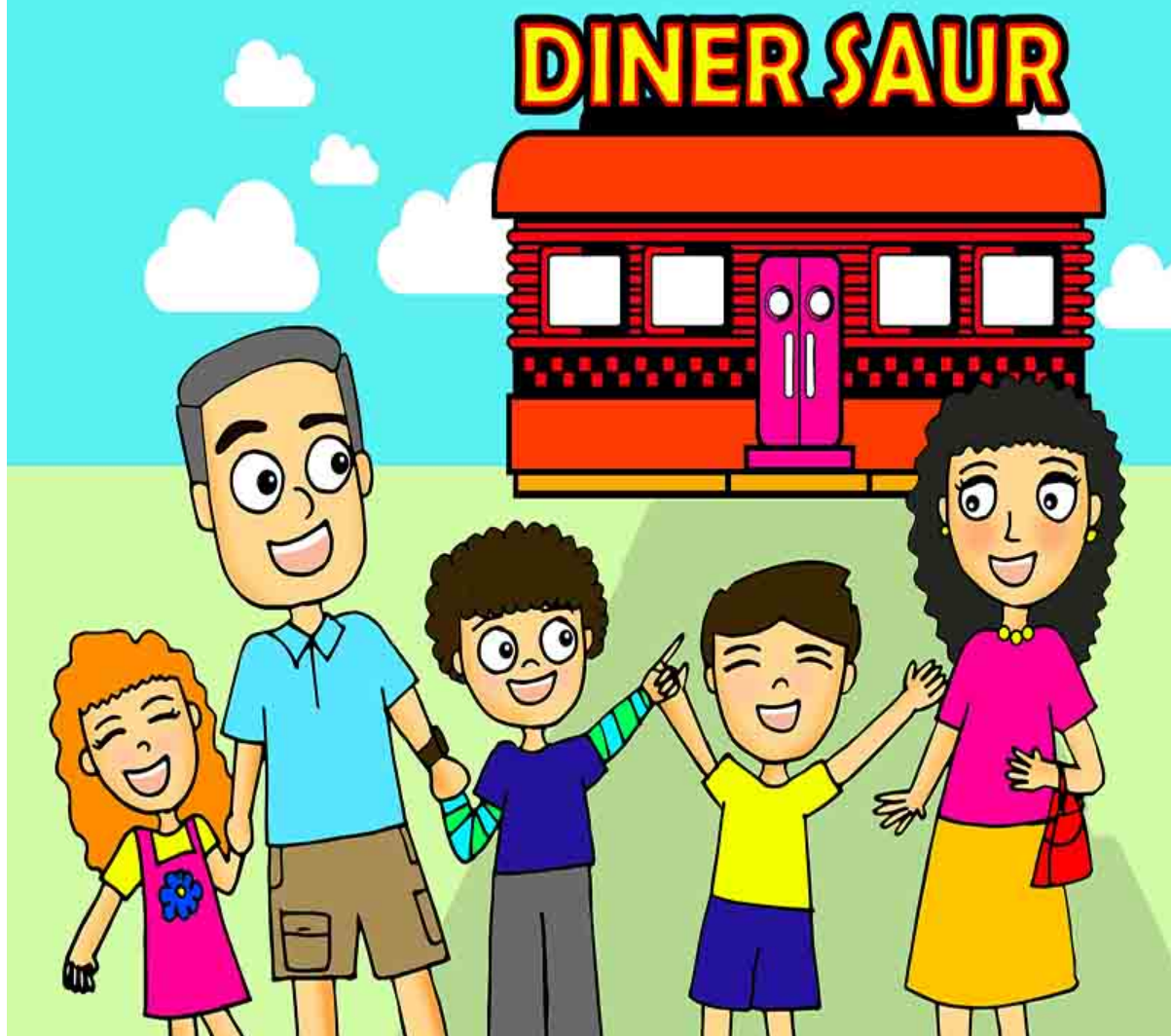
"OK" answered Jeremy.

2000 Hamburgers!"*



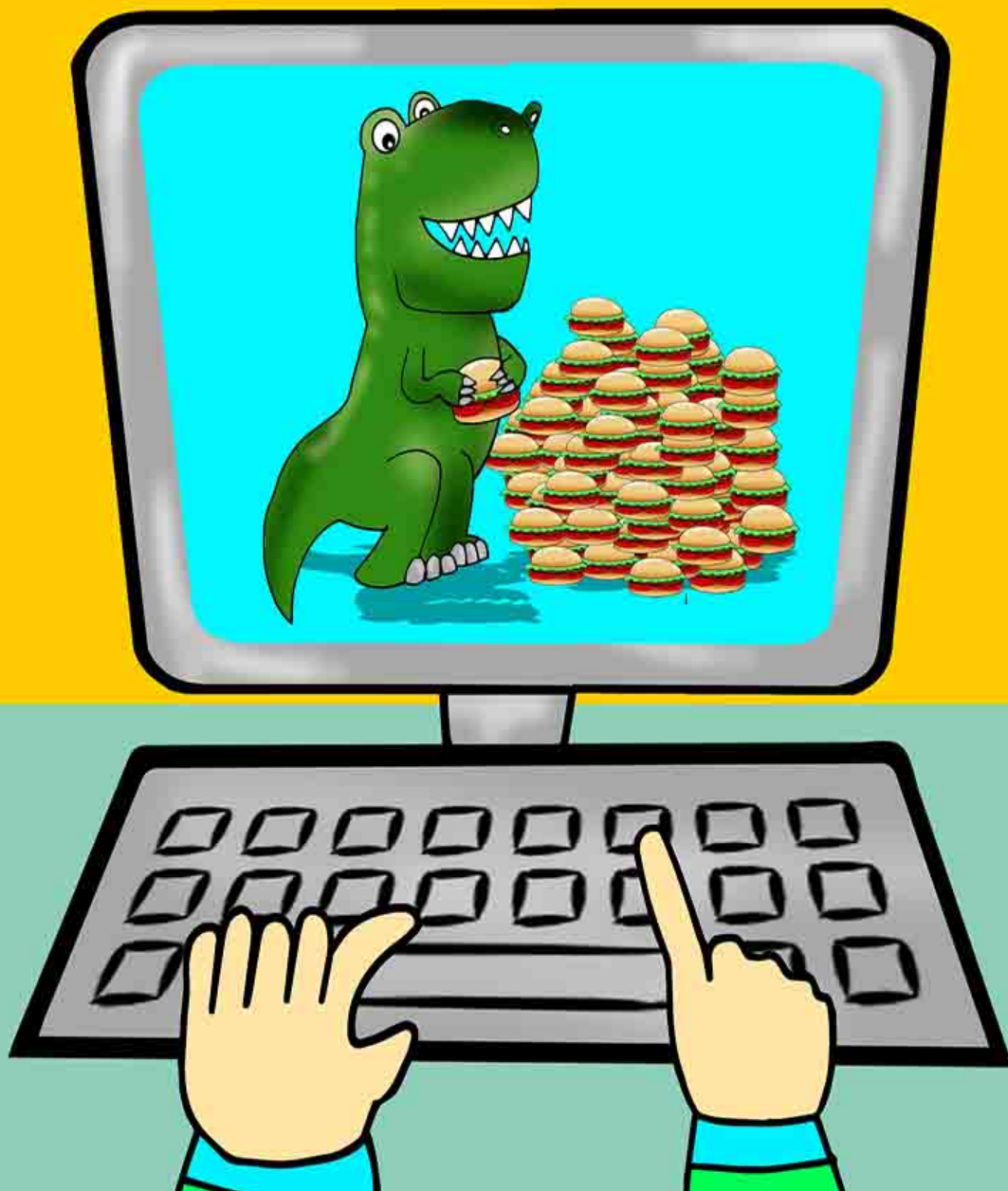
*"2000 Hamburgers! Why so many Jeremy?"

Everyone got what they wanted. Dad, Jeremy, and his little sister each got a hamburger and mom got a big salad.

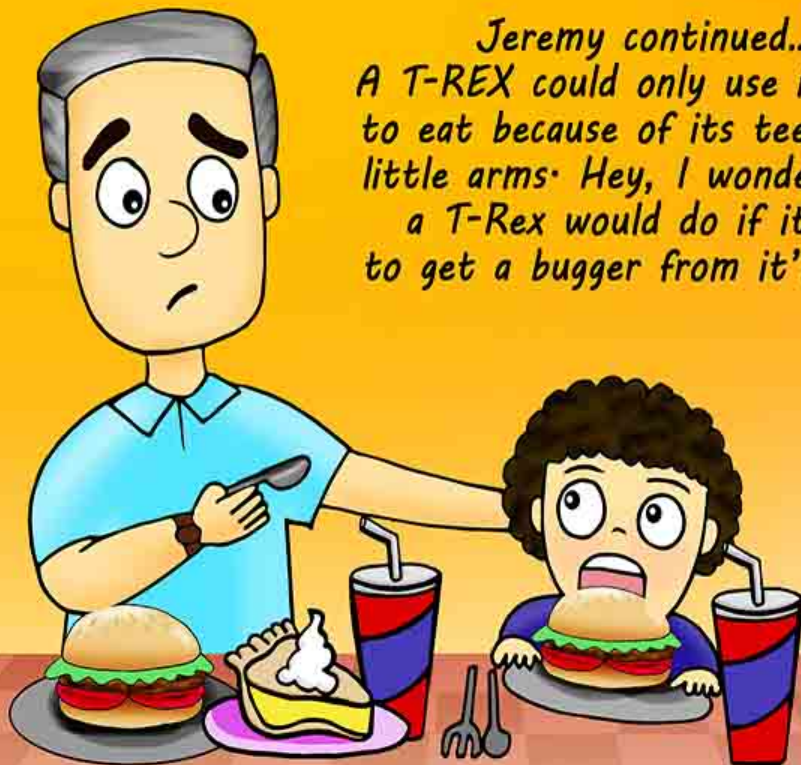

watch what you're saying, Dad said.*

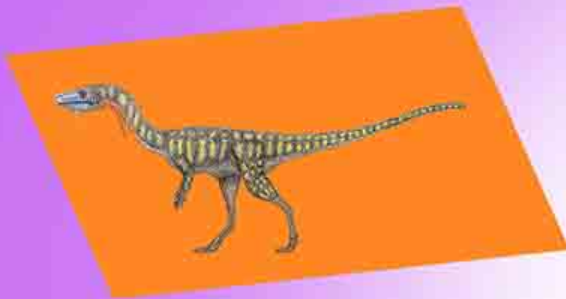
*Jeremy's Mom wanted to know what

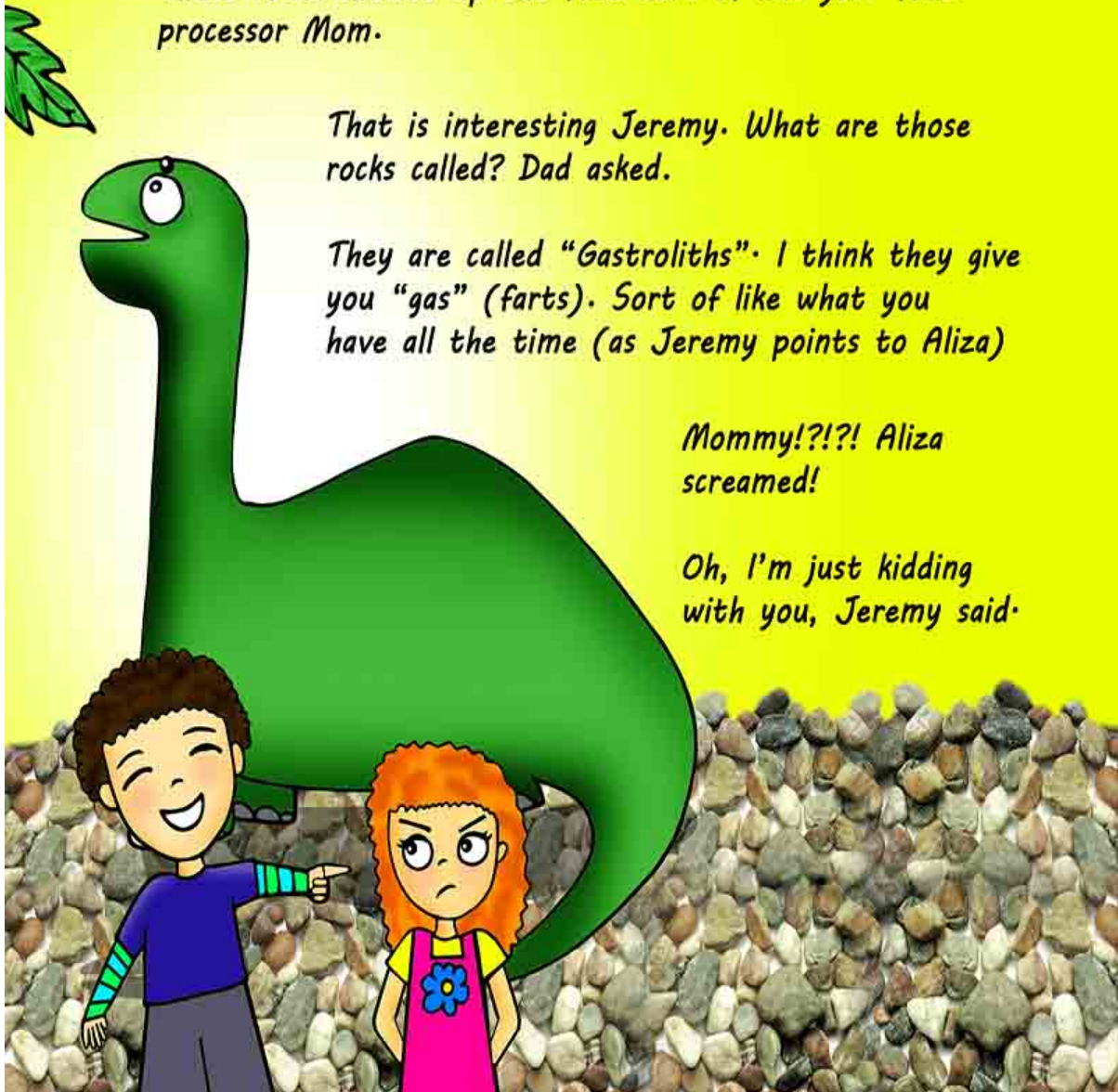

Moms face was in her salad and she was picking up her food with her teeth. A tomato dropped on her lap.

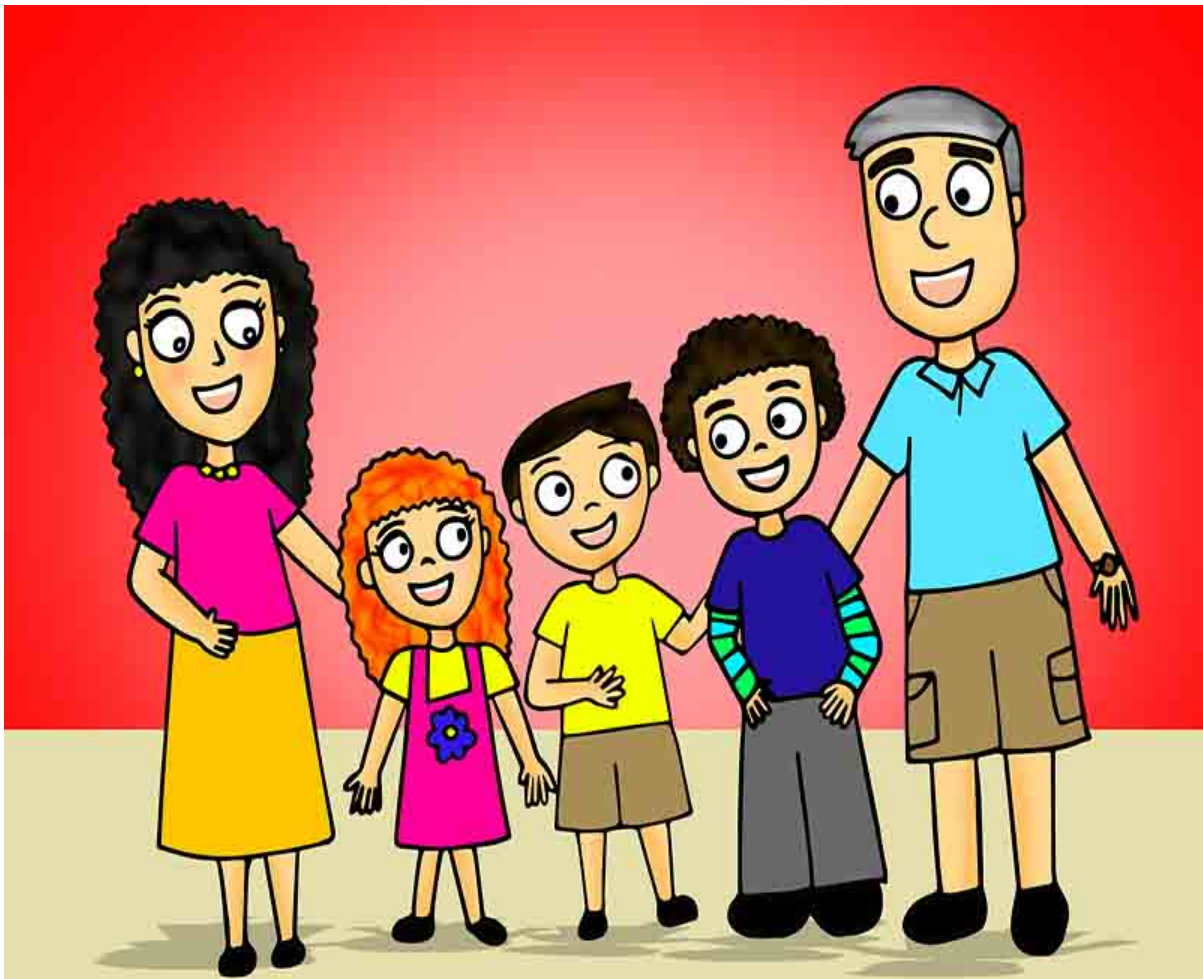


Jeremy's Dad couldn't

a good time eating together.*

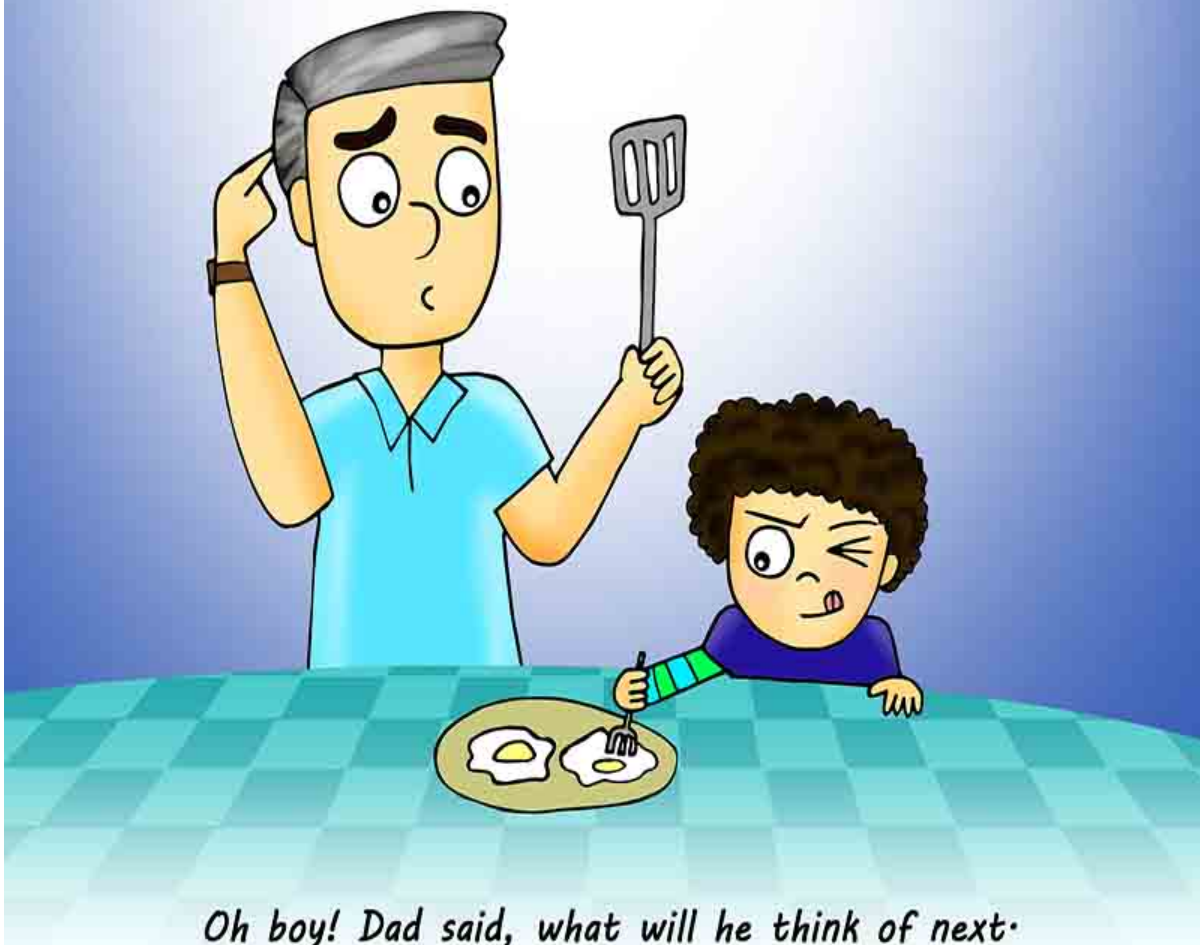
*Mom then said to Jeremy, Aidan and
