- After a recipient has successfully completed one quarter or one semester of higher education, he/she should notify the Prescott Memorial Scholarship Fund Treasurer of his/her enrollment status for the second quarter/semester. It is the responsibility of the recipient to request the award prior to the 15th of April;
  - a. The request must be accompanied by an official, sealed transcript demonstrating successful completion (2.0or higher) of the preceding quarter/semester
  - b. A copy of the registration receipt for the following quarter/semester should also be included with the request.
- 3. Awards will be made to the recipient only if the student is attending an accredited institution.
- 4. Scholarship money will be sent directly to the student unless other arrangements have been made with the Prescott Memorial Scholarship Fund Treasurer.
- 5. Scholarship award money must be used in the academic year of the award. If an award is not claimed prior to the 15th of April, the money will remain in the general scholarship fund account to be re-awarded in the following academic school year.
