# **BUILD A BEE!**

Brooklyn Bridge Park is home to many plants and flowers that depend on bees to help them reproduce. Celebrate the importance of these amazing pollinators by building your own paper towel or toilet paper bee!

# MATERIALS YOU'LL NEED:

- Paper towel or toilet paper roll
- Print out wings (attached)
- Yellow paint, crayons, or paper
- Tape or Glue
- Pipe cleaners, twist ties, or two cut strips of paper
- Black crayon, pen, or marker

## **BEGIN! FOLLOW THESE STEPS:**

#### STEP 1

Grab a paper towel or toilet paper roll to use as the bee body and one set of wings from the attached printout.

## STEP 2

Color your bee with any yellow and black art supplies you have. Don't forget to draw eyes and a few black stripes!

## STEP 3

Cut out your bee wings from the attached printout and glue the wings to the backside of your bee.

## STEP 4

Tape an antenna to the top inside using your pipe cleaners, twist ties, or two cut strips of paper.
