Since the AP Exams this year will be completed online, I feel a need to check to see how you receive future, all-important emails from College Board. In the next few days or weeks, College Board will contact you to explain how you can access this year's AP Exams. The exams will start May 11 and run through May 22. **EXPECT TO BE NOTIFIED BY COLLEGE BOARD SOON.**

PLEASE at this time, access your College Board account we used to register you for this year's exams and be sure that the email address that you listed is correct AND convenient so College Board can contact you. I have asked our district's technology department to recognize the College Board email address so Sheridan High School students might receive their messages, for those who listed their school email in their College Board accounts.

- You will need your password to your College Board account. IF unknown, please call the Student and Parent Helpline at College Board: (888) 225-5427 or (212) 632-1780
 As before, they may ask for your security answer in order to access your personal account.
 BE SURE YOU KEEP UP WITH YOUR PASSWORD.
- 2. When viewing your College Board account, to the right, click on: MY ACCOUNT, Update Email Address. If you need additional help, please contact your teacher!
- 3. Especially, this is important to check since you may have updated your technology since last fall, or you used another person's work email. Please double check to be sure the email address is correct so College Board can send you the expected important messages.
