PREPARE
Before reading today's passage, take a moment to pause in prayer.
<ul> <li>What person or event you're concerned about comes to mind? Write them down.</li> <li>(Identifying them sets the stage for God to dialogue with you as you read today's passage.)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Write down an adjective that describes how you feel about the people or event.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Write one sentence that starts with "Yesterday" (Getting in touch with where you are emotionally will prepare you to hear more clearly from God.)</li> </ul>
STUDY
Read the passage four times.
• First time: Scan the passage quickly just to get the general flow.
• <b>Second time</b> : Circle or underline any words that jump off the page. Draw a box around structural markers (words that tell you the direction of communication, i.e.: because, so that, for.)
<ul> <li>Third time: Jot down your observations. What is the main message or idea you gleaned from the passage?</li> </ul>
• Fourth time: Pick one verse that speaks to you in particular; write it down.
