- I. We are confronted with the <u>INHERENT VALUE</u> of each and every person
 - a. Jesus crosses over an ethno-religious barrier
 - b. Jesus crosses over a gender barrier
 - c. Jesus crosses over a reputation barrier
- 2. We are confronted with the **AVAILABILITY** of salvation for all
- 3. We are confronted with the <u>METHODOLOGY</u> of Jesus in reaching out
 - a. Jesus was humble
 - b. Jesus was relational
 - c. Jesus was also direct
- 4. Ultimately, we are confronted with a big question, do we **LOYE** like Jesus
